Reserved Main Stage Seating Now Available at the 18th Annual Oxnard Salsa Festival

Oxnard, CA – Festival goers attending the 18th Annual Oxnard Salsa Festival can get even closer to the music, dancing and electrifying sounds of salsa with Main Stage Reserved Table Seating available for both the Friday Night Kick-off Concert and all throughout the festival weekend!

The fun starts Friday night, July 29 at 7 p.m. with the Festival Kick-off Concert featuring the Susie Hansen Latin Band.
